WEDNESDAY, 23 FEBRUARY 2022

1. The House met at 14:01.

The vacancy which occurred owing to the resignation of Mr S N August had been filled by the nomination of Mr B N Herron with effect from 02 February 2022.

The vacancy which occurred due to the passing of Mr M N Nxumalo had been filled by the nomination of Mr S S Zondo with effect from 08 February 2022.
